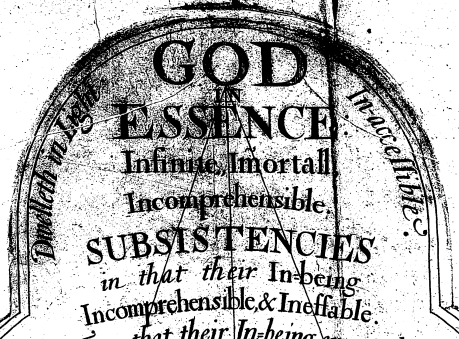

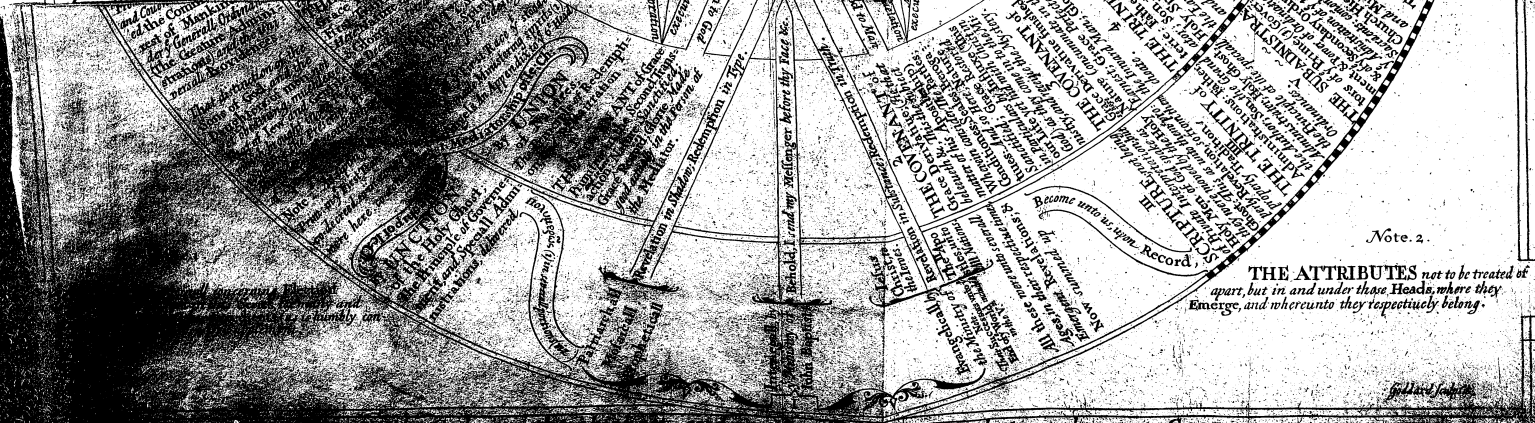
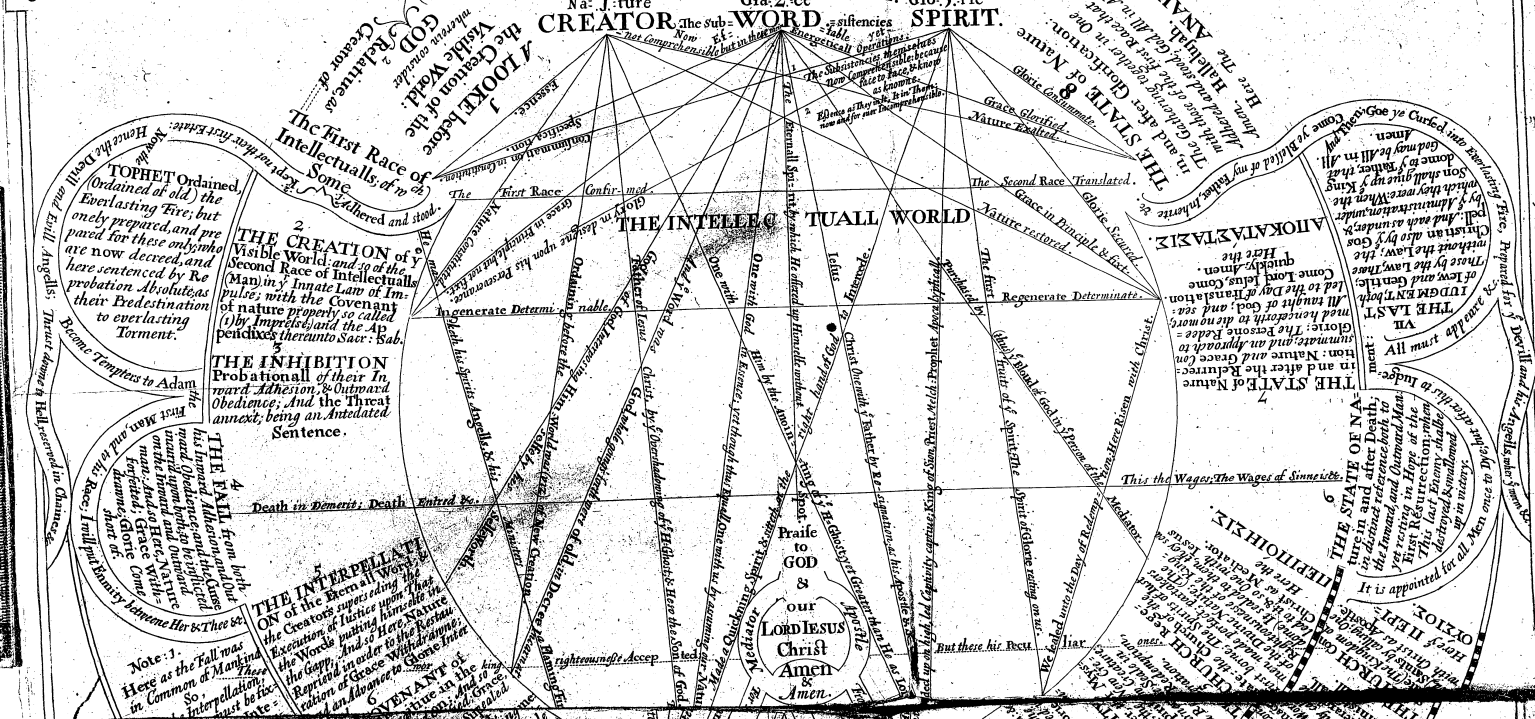


A SUMME OR BODY Stating & Fundamentall (in Modell) for evidencing & fixing the Hee that Prophecieth, let him prophesie
