

99 **W**hofoeuer is annoynted foꝛ the Neopolytane Disease (comonly called the French pocks) if he hold in his mouth a Kyng of golde, oꝛ els an other peece of gold, and rowles the same about in his mouth with his tongue, the quicksyuer that is in his body by the meanes of the oymntment, is dratone of þe sayde gold, and is so wꝛapt about the sayd Kyng, oꝛ golde: that when the same is taken out of his mouth, it shall seeme as though it were all Syuer. And the same Kyng oꝛ other golde wyll not be restozed to his former brightnesse oꝛ cullour, except it be put into the fyꝛe. Lemnius wyꝛtes this.

100 **S**nailes without their Shelles, oꝛ other wyse with their Shells stamped & myxed somtimes with Chelleppe oꝛ Kemmet, do drawe out thoznes oꝛ any other thing out of the fleshe though neuer so deepe, if they be applyed to the place. And also being layde to the bellye of them that haue the Dropsie they sucke out the water. But the same must not bee loosed from the bellye, vntyll all the humour oꝛ water bee sweate foꝛth, oꝛ else the same plaster of Snayles doth fall away of him selfe. Iacob. Hollerius.
